Steps 2, 3, 4 and 5 gather the species detail

- Record full species list for the field, roughly estimate cover of wildflowers and sedges.
- Gather species data at each of 10 stops 1 metre area
- Work out frequencies of species from each stop and note any negative indicators
- Positive indicator species (bold) 2 positive indicators to be frequent (found at 5 or more stops) and 2 occasional (3- 4 stops)
