1. Countryside Stewardship and Environmental Land Management schemes (ELMs)
2. Forestry Commission grants e.g. EWCO
3. Community Forest grants
4. Funding In Protected Landscapes (FIPL)
5. Biodiversity net gain
6. Others e.g. nutrient offsetting, corporate ESG, landfill tax, National Lottery, miscellaneous grants etc
